

# Sigmac iLife in My Life Contest

## Official Rules (Draft 1.0)

### 1. Eligibility

Any full-time or part-time student (undergraduate or graduate) at Case Western Reserve University is eligible to participate in the Sigmac iLife in My Life Contest.

### 2. Teams

Teams may consist of 1 to 4 eligible students. Team submissions will be judged equally with individual entries.

### 3. Contest Period

The contest begins at the Sigmac meeting on October 10, 2007 at 6:00 PM. Submissions are due on November 7, 2007 by 11:59 PM. Judging will take place beginning with the submission deadline until the Awards Ceremony on November 14, 2007 at 6:00 PM.

### 4. Entry Guidelines

Multimedia entries may fall into one of three categories: video, audio, or photo. Video submissions are limited to 5 minutes in length and must be created in Apple iMovie. Audio submissions are limited to 3 minutes in length and must be created in Apple GarageBand. Photo submissions should be 10 printed pages and must be created using Apple iPhoto.

Submitted video, audio, and photos may not contain any inappropriate content (including, without limitation, nudity, defamatory, pornographic, unlawful, discriminatory or vulgar content or language) or else such entries will be disqualified.

Entrants represent and warrant that each submitted entry, including video, music, lyrics, audio, graphics and other, is wholly original and owned by them and is not copied from any commercial or proprietary source or otherwise copyrighted.

Royalty free music and sounds effects can be obtained from the Freedman Center.

### 5. Judging

Judging decisions in each category will be based on the use of iLife features as well as general creativity, with creativity more heavily weighted. Judges will include the Sigmac

Officers, Professor and Sigmac advisor Chris Butler, and other members of the Case community.

## 6. Prizes

Prizes will include Apple-themed pastries provided by Sigmac and assorted Apple gear (not electronics) provided by the Campus Apple Representative. These prizes may be enhanced at the discretion of the Sigmac officers.

## 7. Updates
